The College Evacuation Plan is designed to cover a variety of emergencies including earthquakes, fires, gas leaks and power outages. Each building has at least one designated site to evacuate to as indicated by one of the letters, **A** through **F** listed below. Please keep the roadways and walkways clear for emergency vehicles.

When you evacuate a building, stay calm, take all of your personal belongings with you and exit in an orderly manner. In the case of an earthquake, first take cover in the fetal position away from windows and under a sturdy object. Begin evacuating once the shaking stops. Do not use the elevator and do not use the footbridge until it is determined safe to do so. Once at an evacuation site the instructor or safety marshal will conduct roll so that all can be accounted for. **Do not re-enter the building until given the “All Clear” sign from Security or Facilities.**




In the event of an act of violence, threat of violence or hazardous chemical release it may be necessary to take shelter in place, inside with doors and windows barricaded shut. **Stay in place until given the okay to leave by the Police or Fire Department.**
